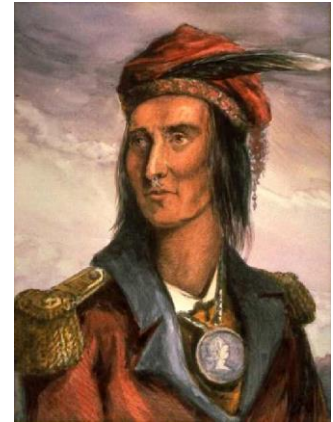


# SEQUOYAH



- MEMBER OF THE CHEROKEE TRIBE
  - NEVER TAUGHT TO READ OR WRITE
  - KNEW WRITTEN LANGUAGE WOULD BE BENEFICIAL TO HIS TRIBE
  - CREATED THE ALPHABET

# TECUMSEH



- LEADER IN THE SHAWNEE TRIBE OF TENNESSEE
- LEADING WAR CHIEF
- TRIED TO COLLABORATE A GROUP OF TRIBES TO RESIST WHITE SETTLEMENT IN OHIO AND MISSISSIPPI VALLEYS
- DIED IN THE WAR OF 1812 FIGHTING WITH PRO-BRITISH FORCES

# SAGOYEWATHA: RED JACKET



- CHIEF OF THE SENECA TRIBE
  - ALWAYS WORE A RED JACKET THAT WAS GIVEN TO HIM BY THE BRITISH
  - WORKED AS A MESSENGER FOR THE BRITISH
  - WHEN THE WAR OF 1812 BROKE OUT, HE FOUGHT FOR THE UNITED STATES

# SO-PATHLA (SAMUEL BROWN)



- BORN MEMBER OF THE YUCHI TRIBE, BUT BECAME PART OF THE CREEK COUNCIL
- ORPHANED AND RAISED BY A MISSIONARY WHO NAMED HIM SAMUEL BROWN
- APPROACHED BY A CREEK TRIBE MEMBER AND ASKED TO TRANSLATE A LETTER FROM AN AMERICAN COLONEL INTO CREEK LANGUAGE FOR THEIR TRIBE
- TOOK A HIGH POSITION AS A FIRST INDIAN HOME GUARD

# PIOMINGO, THE "MOUNTAIN LEADER"



- WAR CHIEF IN THE CHICKASAW TRIBE
- CHICKASAW PEOPLE LOOKED AT HIM SIMILARLY TO HOW AMERICANS LOOK AT GEORGE WASHINGTON
- ENCOURAGED THE CHICKASAW TRIBE TO BECOME FRIENDS WITH THE AMERICANS
